In case of a tie for High in Trial or High Combined, the Judge for the run-off will be designated by the Event Committee from among the Judges of the Obedience Trial.

A dark green qualifying ribbon is offered to all dogs earning a qualifying score in the Obedience and Rally Classes. Prizes in Regular Obedience and Rally events require qualifying scores and must be claimed the day of the trial. A qualifying score is required for all prizes except first through fourth in the non-regular classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Pre-Novice Class: The Pre-Novice Class shall be for dogs that have not received a third qualifying score in a Novice Class prior to the closing of the trial. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. However, if a person has handled more than one dog in the first four exercises, that person must provide a handler for the additional dog in the same Group Exercise. All exercises will be scored as in the Novice Class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be 6 feet in length.

Veterans Class: The Veterans Class will be for dogs that have an obedience title and are at least 7 years old on the date of the trial. The exercises will be performed and judged as in the Novice Class. Dogs may be entered in another class or classes.

WILDCARD CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Wildcard Novice

The Wildcard Novice class is for any dog that is capable of performing the Novice exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Novice exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Novice class, **except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized.** (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as the regular Novice class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as the regular Novice class.

Wildcard Open

The Wildcard Open class is for any dog capable of performing the Open exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Open exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Open A class, **except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized.** (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Open A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Open class.

Wildcard Utility

The Wildcard Utility class is for any dog capable of performing the Utility exercises and that is eligible under the Obedience Regulations to compete in AKC events. No title is required to enter, and handlers may enter more than one dog. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person, and may be entered in another class or classes. The Utility exercises will be performed and judged as in the regular Utility A class, **except that verbal praise during the exercises is to be encouraged and not penalized.** (Good, yes, nice, super, great, attaboy, are some examples of praise that would be allowed.) Handlers may give additional commands, but they will be penalized accordingly. Each handler may choose to skip one exercise and receive full credit for that exercise. When checking in, the handler must inform the steward or judge which exercise will be skipped. If an exercise is skipped, it cannot be performed. If the handler chooses to perform all of the exercises, all will be scored. The exercises will be performed in the same order as in the regular Utility A class. The point values for the exercises, scoring and maximum total points are the same as in the regular Utility class. **Handlers are allowed to praise their dogs during the performance of all Utility exercises except the signal exercise.**

The Trial Secretary will add on a collection fee to the amount of each returned check and may require any subsequent entry fees on a CASH ONLY BASIS. Entries Close at 5:00 p.m. CST on Wednesday, June 18, 2008, after which time no entry may be received, canceled or changed. Entries may be changed prior to closing by sending a WRITTEN request to the Trial Secretary. Entries sent by overnight mail or by an express delivery service MUST HAVE THE SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT WAIVED. ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Trial site will be available to all Exhibitors at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, July 4, 2008. No Dogs May be Left at the Show Site Overnight. Dogs must be removed from the Trial site immediately following the award of High in Trial on Sunday, July 6, 2008. These Trials are governed by the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC Agreement on the backside of the Entry Form in the Premium List.

ADDITIONAL RULES

1. Fees must accompany entries. RROTC and/or the Trial Committee assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. RROTC and/or the Trial Committee assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice. Obedience Trial entries please refer to *AKC Obedience Regulations Amended to August 13, 2007*, and Rally Trial entries please refer to *AKC Rally Regulations Effective January 1, 2008*, regarding descriptions of classes and eligibility. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures, or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.
2. Entry fees will NOT be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or because it has been entered incorrectly.
3. Bitches in season are not allowed at these events. Entry fees for bitches coming in season after entries close will be refunded, less a \$6.00 handling fee, *with written certification from a Veterinarian* and which are presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the judging of the first class.
4. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
5. No entry fees will be refunded if the Trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of RROTC and/or the Trial Committee.
6. Refunds of \$8.00 or less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.
7. Declination of Entries: RROTC and/or the Trial Committee may decline any entries for just cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of aggression, viciousness, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against RROTC and/or the Trial Committee or any official thereof.
8. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, telegram or e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.
9. All Obedience and Rally events are open to all dogs the age of six (6) months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained American Kennel Club ILP numbers except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. All dogs should be physically sound and no dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under six (6) months of age are strictly prohibited from the Trial grounds.
10. Move-ups for the Obedience and Rally Trials will not be allowed after the closing of entries.
11. Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, communicable diseases and have had the appropriate vaccinations.
12. RROTC and/or the Trial Committee reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
13. All prizes must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed.
14. Dogs will not be allowed in the Lobby of the Bossier City Civic Center.
15. Except when in the ring, *all dogs must be on leash* at all times while on the show premises.
16. Only dogs that are eligible to be shown under The American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUDGING

1. Judging will start promptly. During the hours of judging, owners are to be on call and have their dogs ready to bring into the ring promptly in order that the judging will not be delayed.
2. It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to have his dog ready and at the entrance of the ring when the Steward calls for the Class. Owners or agents of the dog alone are responsible for the presence of the dogs in the rings. There is no rule that requires the Judge to wait for a late dog. No public address system shall be used to notify individual Exhibitors that they should be at ringside.
3. Judging procedures may be modified to accommodate disabled handlers.

LOSS OR DAMAGE

1. RROTC and/or the Trial Committee assume no responsibility for any loss, damage to, injury or death sustained by any Exhibitor, Handler, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children whether the result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at these Trials is in the care, custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
2. Any Exhibitor whose dog and/or child creates unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engages in unsafe behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made.
3. The welfare of Exhibitor's children is the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is expressly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. Parents will be responsible for the safety of their children and damages done by their children.
4. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. RROTC and/or the Trial Committee reserve the right to remove any dogs found in distress in a vehicle on the Show grounds at the cost of the owner.
5. In accordance with Sections I. and II. of *Dealing with Misconduct at American Kennel Club Events*, RROTC and/or the Trial Committee reserve the right to retain Trial Committee jurisdiction over Exhibitors whose names have been referred by hotels/motels as having left their rooms and/or grounds in a state that appears negligent or offensive.
6. In accordance with Section IV of *Dealing with Misconduct at American Kennel Club Events*, any Exhibitor engaging in conduct prejudicial to the sport, including, but not limited to, a demonstration of dissatisfaction with a judge's decision, including refusal to accept a ribbon or throwing a ribbon on the ground; altercations with officials or participants; abusive or foul language in public; and mistreatment of a dog. will be subject to Trial Committee jurisdiction.

PARKING & SET-UP

1. Please observe handicap parking and do not block exits. Please observe "No Parking" signs and do not park on the grass. Some areas may be off limits to dogs. Violators may be issued citations and/or towed at their expense.
2. Loading and unloading must be done at the back of the Civic Center. Crate dollies may not be pulled through the Lobby area and dogs are not allowed in the Lobby area or in the restrooms of the Civic Center.
3. After loading and unloading, vehicles must be moved to the parking area. No parking is allowed immediately adjoining the loading/unloading area.
4. No hookups are available so each RV must be self-contained. No dumping of sewage tanks, gray water or holding tanks are allowed on the Civic Center grounds.
